What has BrightView been up to?

BrightView has continued to grow exponentially! Since our last published newsletter in the Summer of 2017, we have opened our 4th center in Fairfield! This site has 10,000 square feet of clinical space, 3 group rooms, a secluded outdoor patio surrounded by nature and a separate medical wing with a private waiting room.

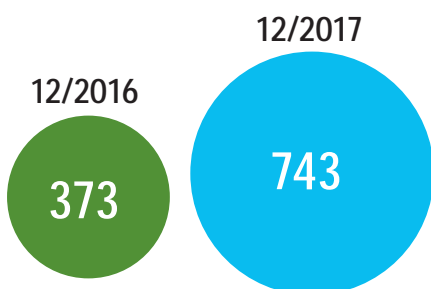


BrightView by the Numbers:

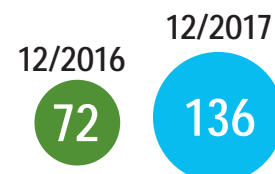
BrightView continually monitors and assesses patient data to ensure we are providing the highest quality of care possible. To that end, we survey our patients every 90 days to evaluate both their progress and ours. In the third quarter of 2017, these were just some of the findings provided by patients who have been at BrightView for 6 months or more:

- Only 28% of patients had a primary care physician (PCP) at admission. Over 50% had a PCP at the 6-month mark – a 78% increase.
- Six months after admission, complaints of chronic depression and/or anxiety decreased by 50%.
- 20% of patients state that their financial situation has significantly improved since admission.
- Six months into treatment, 87% of patients report that the quality of their family relationships are good, very good or excellent.
- Overall well-being of patients has improved by 93% since admission.

(On a scale from 1 to 5, well-being scores improved from an admission average of 1.6 to a >6 month average of 3.1)
